

**Resolution Reduction of Classified Management Services for
the 2021-2022 School Year
Classified Employees
Resolution #20/21-14**

WHEREAS, one of the four goals of the District is to maintain the fiscal solvency of the District and align resources to improve student performance, an analysis was conducted the Facilities department:

WHEREAS, due to lack of work and/or a lack of funds, certain services now being provided by the District must be reduced/or eliminated for the upcoming school year; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 45101, 45114, 45117, 45298 and 45308 authorize the District to layoff classified employees for lack of work and/or lack of funds upon 60 days prior notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that as of the 23rd day of February 2021, the following positions are recommended to be reduced/or eliminated as provided in Exhibit A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Superintendent or designee be authorized and directed to give notice of termination of employment to the affected employee(s) of this District pursuant to District rules and regulations and applicable provisions of the Education Code not later than sixty (60) calendar days prior to the effective date of such reduction or discontinuance as set forth in Exhibit A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Superintendent or designee be authorized and directed to take any other actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
